TASK FORCE ON GOVERNANCE REFORMS AND THEIR MONITORING

Competent Authority has been pleased to constitute a "Task Force on Governance Reforms and their Monitoring" to assist the Chief Minister's Office in furthering the reforms in governance structures. The Task Force shall be headed by Mr. Fazeel Asif Jah, who shall act as its Chairperson and may coopt any other member, if needed, in consultation with this Office.

2. The Terms of Reference of the aforementioned Task Force shall be as under:

- To act as monitoring instrument of the Chief Minister's Office to steer strategic direction of roadmaps and priorities, in line with the vision of Government of the Punjab, through relevant Departments.
- II. To identify specific targets (outcomes and outputs) and plans for efficient service delivery of public goods.

To monitor efficient delivery of public services through an automated Citizens' Grievances Redressal System, as per vision of the Chief Minister Punjab.

evaluate and analyze public data including different stock-takes for taking informed policy decisions and choosing appropriate policy instruments thereof.

To create synergy of efforts amongst various Departments or Agencies for resolving complex cross-agency issues in priority governance areas in line with overall governance targets.

The Task Force shall present its recommendations and reports/to the Chief Ministers' Office on regular basis.
