# **Government College Women University Sialkot**

## 1. Purpose:

GC Women University Sialkot aimed to minimize disposable items such as straws, wrappers, spoons, glass etc. Campus planned to achieve this goal by replacing disposable items used at the university's canteen and labs with alternatives that are sustainable and eco-friendly.

### 2. Strategic Plan:

- Print the double side of the page.
- Submission of projects or assignments should be in soft form to reduce paper waste.
- University management prefer to use the university's organic waste for composting.
- There should be a basket to collect used markers for refilling so that they could be reused.
- The strategy aimed to encourage university staff and students to carry reusable water bottles and administration provided water filters across all university buildings to enable free water to refill the bottles.
